What Benefits Do Employers
Receive From
SEE Hawaii Work?



- SEE assists employers by filling job openings for existing and new positions.
 - SEE matches screened applicants with appropriate available positions. These individuals have applied for, are currently receiving or have exhausted their Unemployment Insurance benefits.
 - SEE reimburses employers at a rate equal to **100 percent of the State minimum wage, plus 50 cents for each additional \$1 per hour paid over the minimum wage, plus 14 percent of the total subsidized wages.** This helps cover employment-related and training expenses.

About the SEE Hawaii Work Program

- SEE is a State of Hawaii initiative that helps eligible individuals obtain paid work experience with long-term employment prospects.
- SEE agreements may last up to six months.
- SEE employees earn standard industry wages and receive the same benefits – such as paid vacation and sick leave – as other employees in similar positions.

SEE Hawaii Work and You

- SEE is a voluntary program.
- SEE helps you meet your job search requirements by providing job opportunities that suit your skills and experience.
- SEE participants are required to work **40 hours a week**.
- Your resume is referred to appropriate job openings with SEE employers seeking skilled or entry-level employees

Eligibility Self-Certification

- I have a child less than 19 years of age.
- My household gross income does not exceed 300 percent of the Federal Poverty Level for Hawaii (see table below).
- I have applied for, I am currently receiving or I have exhausted my unemployment benefits.
